- **MATHEMATICS**
- The children will be learning about properties of 2D and 3D shapes.
- They will also be learning how to find fractions of a shape, quantity and number.



COMPUTING

Presenting Ideas:

- The children will examine a traditional tale presented as a mind map, a quiz, an e-book and a fact file.
- The children will make a quiz about a story using 2Quiz and make a publisher fact file on a non-fiction topic.



MUSIC

- The children will learn the song 'Zootime' a reggae song written especially for children.
- They will develop their understanding of pulse, rhythm and pitch as well as how to play instruments with increasing accuracy.
- They will also be practising how to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song as well as listen to and appraise classic Reggae songs.



The children will learn the importance of water and find out how different communities express beliefs and values through water.



ENGLISH

- Children will read the True Story of the Three Little Pigs and use the text to write a set of instructions and a character description
- The children will also be reading The Last Wolf and will be using it to write a letter and a narrative



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

Sending and Receiving: The children will learn how to roll and receive a ball with their hands and feet, develop their throwing and catching skills and send and receive a ball using a racket.



TOPIC

- History: The children will be learning about the wonders of the world. They will name and place them on a timeline and use a wide range of historical vocabulary
- Design Technology: The children will design and make a model of a chosen wonder of the world. They will investigate cutting, joining and strengthening techniques



SCIENCE

Plants

- The children will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants
- · They will find out and record how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy



PSHE
