


PARENTS' GUIDE TO THE CURRICULUM

This information will give you an understanding of what your child is learning at school in Spring 1

MATHEMATICS




I will be learning to add and subtract with numbers up to 10.

I will be learning about numbers up to 15.

I will continue learning about measurements, time, and the calendar.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

I will explore my learning through movement, for example moving like the characters in "We're going on a bear hunt."



I will be getting changed for PE more independently.

COMMUNICATON AND LANGUAGE

I will listen attentively to stories and respond with relevant actions or comments.



I will role-play and act out the stories I have learned.

LITERACY

I will be reading books about bears, including non-fiction books and stories such as "Where's my Teddy?", "We're going on a Bear Hunt" and "Goldilocks."

I will be linking letters to sounds and using them in my reading and writing.


I will write a letter to send home about what teddy did at school.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

I will be learning about different kinds of bears and where they can be found.

I will be making a map of my journey to the post box.

I will be looking at similarities and differences between real bears and between teddy bears.

I will be learning about road safety.
I will talk to my friends about my teddy.
