Remote Learning: Information for Parents

- All remote learning will take place on Google Classroom.
 - Children log in via the QR code sent in September.
- If passwords have been forgotten, parents should contact the class teacher via the class email address.
- Weekly timetables and further details regarding remote learning are posted on the school website under the home learning tab.
- All children must complete a daily attendance question on their Google Classroom before 9.30am.
- Daily work will consist of: English, Maths, and 2 other subjects (Science, computing, PE, PSHE, Music, Topic etc.)
- 1 lesson per day will be a live lesson. Links will be posted on the Google Classroom page. This will take place via Google Meet.
- All work completed must be 'turned in' so teachers are able to give feedback.




- Type Google Classroom in the search box and select the first link that comes up
