How Parents Can Help

Ensure child has a healthy breakfast each morning to prepare them for the day.

Make sure your child reads daily for 1 hour.

Help your child learn their spelling list.

Maths

- Children will build on their understanding of area and perimeter by exploring the area of triangles and parallelograms. They will also revisit the difference between volume and capacity.
- Children will be introduced to ratio and relate that understanding to using scale and proportion to calculate.
- Children will revisit line graphs and well as reading and interpreting pie charts with percentages to solve problems.



Computing

- Children will become reporters where they will create articles based on key events in the Roman Empire, with a focus on the impact they had on Britain.
- They will also use desktop publishing to insert photographs and share information.



Music

- Children will continue to explore Samba and participate in singing a range of songs from different cultures and in different languages with more confidence.
- They will explore various musical styles with appropriate feel and expression, demonstrating greater control when they perform with energy and enthusiasm.



RE

- Children will continue to learn about Sikhism.
- They will learn the festivals, traditions and about the customs of this faith.



ENGLISH

- Children will write a class book to share their experiences of lockdown and to share their hopes for the future.
- They will have the opportunity to develop their journalistic skills, which includes ensuring writing content is clear, concise and cohesive.



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- This term children will be looking practicing jumping, running, throwing and catching, in isolation and in combination.



TOPIC

- In History, children will explore the impact and influence of Romans on Britain.
- They will contribute to a school time capsule to commemorate the 2021 census.



SCIENCE

- This term children will be investigating Evolution and Inheritance, where they will look at how living things produce offspring that are similar in appearance, but identical to themselves, whether they are plants or animals.
- They will also consider how animals change over time as they adapt to their surroundings and this leads to longer term changes.



PSHE

- Children will be looking at Planet Diversity in iSpace and reflecting on how our diverse community brings positive experiences.
- They will also continue to explore gender differences as well as exploring ways to change negative gender differences they encounter.
- To understand homelessness and the reasons for it



SPANISH

- Children will be learning more about Spanish culture and life in Spain.
- They will also continue to practise numbers and colours whilst revising previously taught concepts from the beginning of this academic year.
