We will continue to have the following measures to reduce the risk of catching Covid.

- Children will still wash their hands regularly
- Classrooms and the school building will continue to be well ventilated
- Visitors and parents will continue to have restricted access into the building
- Water fountains will still remain off and children must bring in a water bottle daily

Please note the latest Covid Guidance states:

From 16 August 2021, individuals identified as a contact of a confirmed case of COVID-19 in England will be exempt from the legal duty to self-isolate, this includes children under the age of 18 years and 6 months.

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All children with Covid symptoms must stay at home and get a PCR test to confirm if they have Covid. If the test is positive they must isolate for 10 days.

If a parent/carer or family member living in the household tests positive for Covid then all children in the house MUST have a lateral flow test, which is free and available free online from the NHS website. If the test is negative then children can return to school if they have no symptoms.

## Uniform

The children are looking very smart in our new uniform. Due to circumstance beyond our control some sizes are out of stock. I appreciate your patience while Jiff works hard to replenish stock. In the meantime, children are able to wear their old school jumper and PE kit. Thank you to parents who have given us feedback on the service they have received.
