MATHEMATICS

- The children will apply their number knowledge in multiplication and division.
- They will explore number fractions – whole, half and quarter.
- They will also learn about position and direction.



COMPUTING

We are Collectors

- The children will search for pictures of animals using a custom search.
- They will use PowerPoint to create presentations



MUSIC

- Children will develop their musicianship through developing more complex singing with a wider vocal range.
- They will play patterns on percussion.



RE

- Children will learn about how to care for our world. They will think about why it is important to care for our world and what happens if we do not do this.



ENGLISH

- Children will be reading The Night Pirates and Where the Wild Things Are.
- They will be writing letters, character descriptions, poetry and their own narratives.
- Reading & Phonics: The children will continue daily phonics sessions and reinforce their reading skills through Daily Supported Reading.
- Spelling: Year 1 will learn how to read, write and spell high frequency words.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- The children will learn about athletics.
- They will learn to run in a straight line and how to stop with control.
- They will identify and explore changes in speed and direction and how to intercept a moving object.



TOPIC

- In Geography the children will learn about weather and coastlines.
- They explore the features of the seaside – physical and human features.
- They will make maps of seaside localities using a simple key and be comparing a seaside location to that of the school.



SCIENCE

- The children will learn about everyday materials.
- They will identify them and understand their properties.
- They will continue to learn about seasonal changes.



PSHE and RSE

- Children will read Hot and Cold which will help them to understand how to take care of themselves.
- They will take part in money week.
- They will also learn about growing and changing since birth.
