MATHEMATICS

- Children will learn about how to count in tenths as decimals, converting fractions into decimals, comparing and ordering fractions and how to add/subtract fractions.
- They will learn about time, reading an analogue clock to the nearest minute, using AM and PM and finding duration and comparing duration of time.



COMPUTING

We are communicators

- Children will learn about computer networks including the internet; provide multiple services including the WWW.
- They will learn collaborate via email and teleconferencing.
- Children will use email software, video conferencing and webcams and understand how to use these safely.



MUSIC

- Children will continue to develop singing skills, including singing in rounds. They will use their bodies to produce percussion sounds. They will continue to learn the recorder.



RE

- Children will learn about the religion of Judaism. They will learn about where Jews worship and their sacred holy day and festivities.



ENGLISH

- Children will read and explore the text The Iron Man written by Ted Hughes and Belonging written by Jeannie Baker
- They will write character descriptions, newspapers, poetry, letters and a diary entry .



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Children will explore ways of jumping & landing from a height
- Children will continue the Daily Mile.



TOPIC

- In Geography, children will learn all about volcanoes. They will learn the Earth's structure, how volcanoes are made? What happens when they erupt?
- In History, children will learn about the Stone and Bronze age. They will create timelines, compare and contrast these two periods and learn all about the famous monument called Stonehenge



SCIENCE

- Children will learn about Rocks. They will learn about the different types of rocks and how they are formed.
- They will investigate how waterproof rocks are, how easily they erode and how hard the rock is.



PSHE and RSE

- Children will explore Planet Heads Up.
- They will also learn about money and the importance of economics
- They will explore different types of families.
- They will also explore the difference between wants and needs.



SPANISH
