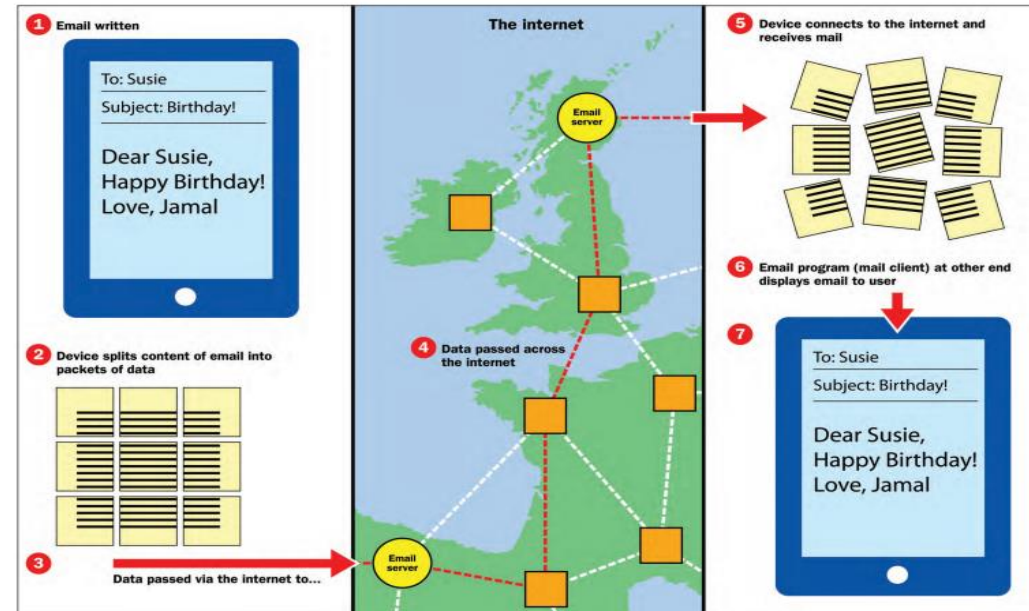

### Key Vocabulary

<b>attachment</b>	A computer file such as an image, video MP3, document or zipped file sent within an email message.
<b>email</b>	Messages sent by electronic means from one computer user to one or more recipients via a network.
<b>Online safety</b>	Being aware of possible threats that you could encounter whilst engaging in activity through the Internet,
<b>Spam</b>	Unwanted messages sent over the internet for the purposes of advertising, phishing, spreading malware, etc.
<b>Spoofed link</b>	A fraudulent link that is masked to look like a legitimate source in order to steal your data.
<b>Video conference</b>	A meeting in which participants in different locations are able to communicate with each other in sound and vision.
<b>virus</b>	A malicious piece of computer code designed to spread from device to device damaging it or stealing a users data at it spreads.



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
