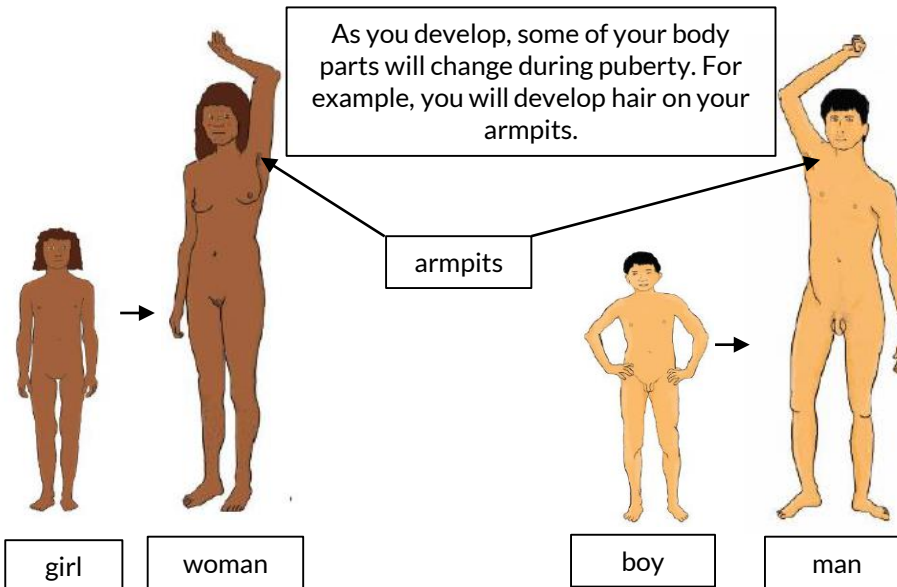
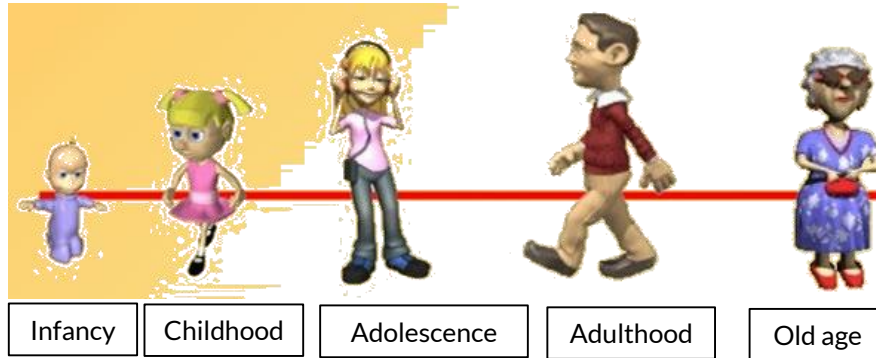
Key Vocabulary
