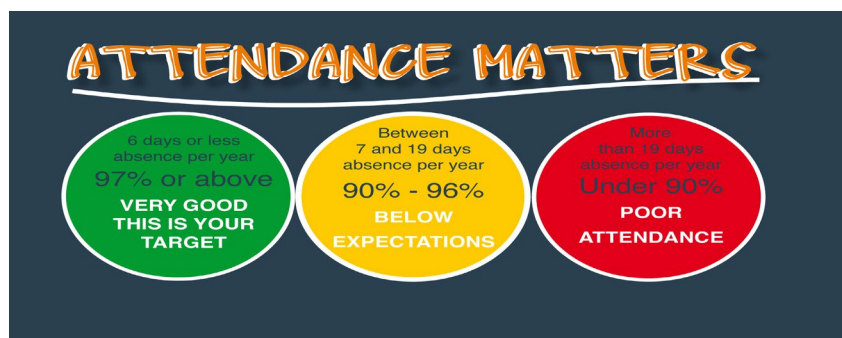
The School will be receiving a Jubilee book for pupils. Once they arrive we will send them home.
