Key Vocabulary

domain	Part of the internet owned by an individual, company or organisation
internet	A way to send information from one computer to another anywhere in the world using technologies such as satellites, phones and radio links.
search engine	A program to help you find web pages on the internet.
web page	A single page which can include images, videos and charts.
website	A collection of web pages that belong to one domain

Follow the SMART rules to help stay safe online.

S **Safe**
Stay **safe** online by not sharing your personal information.

M **Meet**
Do not **meet** anyone who you have only become friends with online.

A **Accept**
Do not **accept** messages and friend requests from people you do not know.

R **Reliable**
Not everything online is **reliable**. People online are strangers and you can't always trust everything they say.

T **Tell**
Tell an adult you trust if anything happens online that you do not like.

Be careful what you share online!
Stop and think before you share information online. Don't say or do anything that you wouldn't do in the real world!
