MATHEMATICS

- ❖ Recite numbers to 5 and beyond;
- ❖ Count using one to one correspondence within 5 and beyond;
- ❖ Experiment with symbols to represent a quantity.



COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

- ❖ Express own feelings using simple sentences;
- ❖ Understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important;
- ❖ Engage in story times.



PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- ❖ Start exploring the learning environment with support;
- ❖ Start joining in play with peers and adults;
- ❖ Begin to moderate their own feelings socially and emotionally.

- ❖ Develop their small motor skills so that they can use a range of tools competently, safely and confidently.

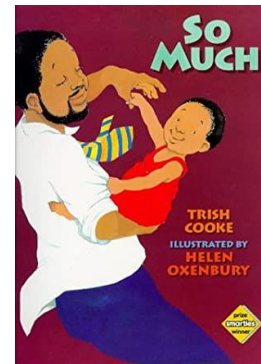


LITERACY

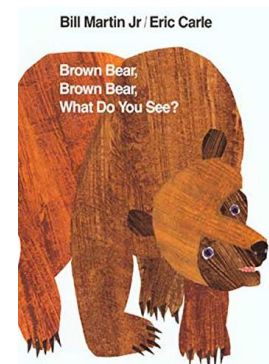
- ❖ Handle books with care;
