MATHEMATICS

- This term in Maths, the children will learn more about place value.
- They will continue to solve addition and subtraction problems.
- They will work on lengths and perimeters.
- They will also be learning about multiplication and division.



COMPUTING

- They will continue to learn about how to stay safe online.



MUSIC

- This term, the children will continue to work with Brent Music Service.

RE

- Children will continue to learn about Hinduism.
- children will explore Hinduism through the story of Rama and Sita.



ENGLISH

- The children will be studying The Journey by Francesca Senna and The Spiderwick Chronicles (The Field Guide) by Holly Black and Tony DiTerlizzi
- They will be writing: diary entries, blog based balanced arguments and non-chronological reports.
- They will also write a setting description in a short narrative.



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- This term, children will be utilising football and fitness games to improve their defending and attacking play skills.



TOPIC

- In Geography, the children will be learning about rivers.
- In History, we will study Ancient Egypt.
- In Art, the children will look at African prints to create their own artwork inspired by Adire Aleko's resist dyeing work.
