## Religion Caring For the World

### Vocabulary

**Care:** to look after and give love to something or someone.

**Creation:** Something being made that was not there before.

**Environment:** the natural world and the impact humans have on their surroundings

**Genesis** Origin, source. Where something comes from.

**Pollution:** anything that makes the earth dirty and unhealthy

### What will be learning about this term:

**Many faiths have a description of how the Earth, the universe and everything in it, were created.**

**Christians, Muslims, and Jews share the creation story, told at the very beginning of their holy texts in a book called Genesis, which means 'origin' or 'source' – where things first began.**

**Not everyone has a faith, and we will explore how people of many walks of life show care to others and to the natural world.**



### Islam:

One of the 5 pillars of Islam is Zakah – an obligation to give money to the poor. It is generally voluntary and a set percentage of someone's wealth.

### Questions we will ask during this unit:

Who cares?

Why do we care?

What does it 'look' like when we care for others?

What do people of faith, and of no faith, believe about looking after our world?



### Judaism:

God gives man control of the environment, but most Jews believe that humans should act responsibly, ensuring the environment is not treated badly. Man has to work within creation and look after it
