### How Parents Can Help

## MATHEMATICS

- ❖ Counting objects and say how many there are.
- ❖ Link numerals and amounts (showing the right numbers of objects to match the numeral, up to 5).
- ❖ Extend and create patterns (leaf, stick, leaf, stick).



## COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

- ❖ Using longer sentences of four to six words.
- ❖ Being able to express a point of view using words as well as actions.



## PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- ❖ Talk about their feelings using words like 'happy', 'sad', 'angry' or 'worried'.
- ❖ Begin to understand how others might be feeling.

### Read together

- ❖ The Gingerbread Man
- ❖ Shark in the dark
- ❖ The Weather Monster



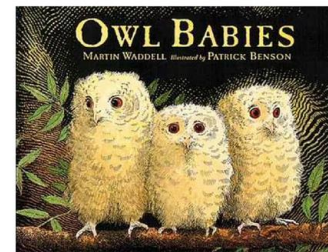
## PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- ❖ Being increasingly independent as they get dressed and undressed, for example, putting coats on and doing up zips.

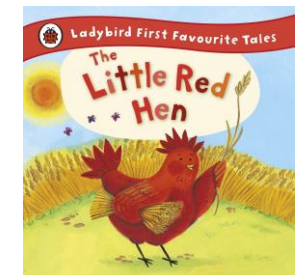


## LITERACY

- ❖ Engaging in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary.
- ❖ Using some of their print and letter knowledge in their early writing, e.g. writing a pretend shopping list that starts at the top of the page; write 'm' for mummy.
- ❖ Writing some or all of their name.
- ❖ Exploring Instrumental sounds and body percussion (auditory training).
