### How Parents Can Help

### MATHEMATICS

- Children will continue to learn about addition and subtraction using a range of strategies.
- Children will also learn about multiplication and division.



### COMPUTING

- Children will learn touch typing and continue to practise their typing skills on the laptop.
- They will create spreadsheets to present their information and data
- They will also learn about simulations. They will learn how to use simulations to represent real or imaginary situations.



### MUSIC

- Children will maintain their part in a group, compose and perform melodic songs, create repeated patterns with a range of instruments.
- They will devise non-standard symbols to indicate when to play and rest. (Recorder)



### RE

- Children will continue to learn about the religion of Hinduism. They learn about what do Hindus learn from Vishnu's stories and symbols



### ENGLISH

- Children will read: Olympig by Victoria Jamieson and The present – film unit
- They will write a character description, diary entry and a poem based on the story Olympig
- They will watch a silent film called The Present. They will write a narrative to go along with it and write their own set of instruction
- Children will continue their DR and DSR sessions.



### PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Children will be focussing on dance.
- They will copy, remember and perform a dance phrase and relate short dance phrases that communicate an idea.
- Children will also continue the Daily Mile.



### TOPIC

- In Geography, children will learn about Mountains and famous Mountain ranges
- In History, children will learn all about Ancient Mesopotamia- They will learn the ways in which Egypt and Sumer were the same and different
- In Art children will Paint portraits of local figures and famous people associated with Wembley.



### Science

- This term, children will learn about forces and magnets. They will learn about pushes and pulls. They will observe how magnets attract or repel each other and some materials. They will be working scientifically by conducting their own experiments.
- Through observation children will discover the properties of magnets and whether different materials have magnetic properties or not



### PSHE and RSE

- Children will explore Planet Confidence and Planet Relationships.
- There will be an anti-bullying week raising awareness of the types of bullying and the effects it has on people.
- Children will also learn about the effects of caffeine.
