Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you to everyone who attend parent consultations last week. With your child being in Year 6 you will already be aware how busy and important this year is. Application forms for high school have been submitted and the hard work continues to prepare the children for the SATS.

You will have seen in the news that there is now an additional bank holiday in May 2023 due to the coronation of King Charles. This means that there will be a change to the SATS timetable for 2023. We have just received confirmation that SATs test will now run from **Tuesday 9 May 2023-Friday 12 May 2023**. The Year 6 teachers will send out the timetable in the new year but please make sure that these dates are in your diary as it is vital that all children are in school for their tests.

Below I have outlined our expectations of all Year 6 children during this time and ask that these are reinforced at home so that all children can achieve good grades. With disrupted education during the Covid Pandemic, teachers will be inviting some children to attend additional Booster sessions, if your child is lucky enough to be offered one, make sure they attend every session weekly and on time.

Home learning must be completed and returned on time. From week beginning 28th November 2022, children will be given homework books to complete their work in.
