Key Vocabulary	
bark	the outer covering of a tree trunk
branch	part of a tree that grows out from the trunk
flower	part of the plant that is often brightly coloured
fruit	fleshy part of the plant that contains seeds or a stone
leaf/ leaves	these are flat, thin and usually green
petal	thin, brightly coloured or white part of the flower
root	the part of the plant that grows under the ground
stem	the upright main stalk of a plant
trunk	large main stem of a tree
