How Parents Can Help

Encourage your child to complete all their home learning . This will be set online via Google Classroom. Please help your child to learn their weekly spellings. Listen to your child read and comment in their reading records.

Remember to wear the correct PE kit to school on PE days (Wednesdays and Fridays).



MATHEMATICS

- Children will learn more about fractions including: equivalency, adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator and how fractions can be represented as being greater than 1.
- They will also be learning about decimals.
- They will learn how to compare and order numbers up to 1 or 2 decimal places.
- They will also be multiplying and dividing decimals by 10 or 100.



COMPUTING

- This term, children will learn the structure of the coding language of Logo.
- They will learn how to input simple instructions into Logo.
- They will use 2Logo to create letter shapes.
- They will use the repeat function in Logo to create shapes. Finally, they will be able to use and build procedures in Logo.



MUSIC

- They will be learning about body percussion and use their knowledge of the instrument in group composition.



RE

- In R.E children will learn all about Judaism.

ENGLISH



- The children will be studying Greek Mythology.
- They will explore descriptive vocabulary, prepositions and fronted adverbials.
- They will be creating a short narrative, a diary and a newspaper article.



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Children will be focusing on tennis.
- They will be learning a range of serving techniques as well as learning how to correctly hold and use a racquet.
- They will send and receive balls and apply these in competition.



TOPIC

- In History, children will learn about the Ancient Greek civilisation.. They will focus on culture, language and beliefs.
- In Geography, children will learn about agriculture. They will recognise that agriculture is the way farmers produce our food, understand the terms arable and pastoral and recognise how seasonal patterns can affect agriculture.



SCIENCE

- In Science, children will consolidate their knowledge of food chains.
- Children will construct scientific method in order to test which types of liquids have negative effects on our teeth.



PSHE and RSE

- Children will explore Planet Resilience.
- They will learn why resilience is an important life skill and how we can learn from mistakes.



SPANISH

- This term, children will be learning vocabulary and phrases connected to habitats.
