MATHEMATICS

- Children will continue their learning about fractions.
- They will learn about how to count in tenths as decimals, converting fractions into decimals, comparing and ordering fractions and add/subtract fractions.
- They will learn about money. They will add and subtract money and find change.
- They will learn about time, Roman numerals, reading an analogue clock to the nearest 5 and 1 minute, using AM and PM and reading digital clocks.



COMPUTING

- Children will learn about how to present work.
- They will learn to use MS PowerPoint and Google Slides.



MUSIC

- Children will continue to develop singing skills, including singing in rounds. They will use their bodies to produce percussion sounds. They will continue to learn the recorder.



RE

- Children will continue to learn about the religion of Judaism. Children will learn and explore the story about Moses and Exodus.



ENGLISH

- Children will read and explore the text Iron Man.
- After reading the text, they will write about the main character. They will describe the character's appearance, their personality in regards to their actions and thoughts.
- They will write a newspaper report/recount about an event that took place in the story



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Children will learn and take part in athletics.
- They will also start preparing for sports day.
- Children will continue the Daily Mile.



TOPIC

- In Geography, children will learn all about volcanoes. They will learn the Earth's structure, how volcanoes are made and what happens when they erupt.
- In History, children will continue to learn about Ancient Greece. They will learn about democracy what democracy it is and how it worked. They will learn about Ancient Greek culture, places and literature.



SCIENCE

- Children will continue to learn about plants
- They will investigate the way in which water is transported within plants.
- They will further explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.
- They will learn about light. They will investigate how shadows are made and can change, and how we can use this to measure time.
- They will learn about the way the Earth moves in relation to the Sun, and how this defines the passage of day and night and the seasons we experience.



PSHE and RSE

- Children will explore the Planet heads-up
- They will learn about how and why we think the way that we do, managing our thoughts.
- They will also learn about types of families.
- There will be Money week, where children learn about understanding of personal finance, saving wisely, credit and debt, keeping money safe and how to budget.
- They will also learn about the difference between needs and wants

SPANISH
