Year 2 SATs

We wanted to write to remind you that Year 2 will be completing their SATs over the next few weeks. These are not anything to worry about and all children in England, in Year 2, will be taking part. This is an assessment process that is designed to support the teachers end of year judgement for reading and maths.

At Brentfield, we are making sure that the children do not feel nervous about these challenges as they are only a small part of their learning journey in Year 2. Over the Spring term, the children have been practicing the assessments to help them feel more confident and comfortable taking part in them.

We will be making sure that pupils work in small groups with adults that they know. They will be given regular breaks and snacks at school during the day. The assessments are not is not timed so pupils can complete it at their own pace.

To best support your child, we would recommend the following

- Eat a healthy breakfast
- Attend school on time.
