

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School Reports

This half term has been a very busy time for pupils completing statutory tests that the government ask all schools to complete. Year 2 and 6 have completed their SATS, Year 1 have completed their Phonic Screen Check (PSC) and Year 4 have completed their multiplication check. All teachers are currently completing their final end of term assessments. **End of term reports will be sent to parents on Wednesday 12**th **July.**



We have many missing books from our library. If you have any unreturned library books or reading books at home please return them by Wednesday 12th July. There will be a £6 fee for any unreturned books.

Thank you to parents raising concerns about parking near the school at the start and end of the day. Sadly, I am seeing an increase in parents and carers driving and parking irresponsibly outside the school. We operate a 'Safer Schools Scheme' which resists access near the school while children enter and exit the school. Parents should not be parking or driving beyond the sign on Meadow Garth Road. Brent council are supporting us and will be sending additional traffic enforcement officers to patrol outside the school. recommend you only use tuition services who use qualified teachers. If you wish to take up tuition for your child, Kip McGrath in Wembley employ qualified teachers as tutors.
