## **How Parents Can Help**

PE is on Thursday and Friday.

One class will go swimming on a Thursday each term.

Please ensure your child has a water bottle and that all of their uniform is labelled.

Encourage your children to deepen their times table knowledge (**TTRockstars**),and strengthen their reading skills and vocabulary.

Ensure your children complete home learning. This will be set on a Friday and should be returned the following Tuesday.



#### **MATHEMATICS**

- This term, children will be looking at multiplication and division. They will study mental strategies and formal calculations.
- Children will consolidate formal methods for the four calculations.
- · Children will begin working with fractions.



## **COMPUTING**

Modelling and Game Creators

- Children will think critically about coding and have the opportunity to create their own game.
- They will also learn the basics of concept mapping and use software to help them generate, visualise and connect their ideas and thought processes.



#### RE

- Children will learn about Christianity
- They will recognise that the Bible is in 2 parts: Old Testament and New Testament
- They will retell the story of the birth of Jesus Christ and his family.



## **ENGLISH**

- This term children will be exploring 'The Boy at the Back of the Class' which is a story about a refugee boy.
- Children will create a formal letter in support of refugees and write a narrative from the boy's point of view.



## PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- This term, children will be developing skills in tennis. This will include throwing and catching as well as racket skills.
