How Parents Can Help

• Please read to your child every day and comment in their reading record. <u>Example</u>: He/she enjoy the book. He/she could talk about the pictures or characters.





- Compare quantities using 'more than', 'fewer than'.
- Understand position through words alone, for example, "The bag is under the table," with no pointing.
- Compare the length of objects e.g. "longer", "shorter".



COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

- Understand a question or instruction that has two parts, such as "Get your coat and wait at the door".
 - Continue to develop language and communication by speaking in clear sentences and beginning to use the correct tense.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Develop their sense of responsibility and membership of a community.
- Become more outgoing with unfamiliar people, in the safe context of their setting.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Go up steps and stairs or climb apparatus, using alternate feet.
- Skip, hop, stand on one leg and hold a pose for a game like musical statues.
- Use large-muscle movements to wave flags and streamers, paint and make marks.
- Use and remember sequences and patterns of movements which are related to music and rhythm.

LITERACY

- Engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary
- Use some of their print and letter knowledge in their early writing. For example: writing a pretend shopping list that starts at the top of the page; write 'm' for mummy.
- Write their name.

AUDITORY TRAINING

To develop awareness of rhythm and rhyme and Alliteration through stories and exploring words that have the same sounds.
