Maths

- Children will begin a unit on ratio and proportion.
- Children will be developing their reasoning skills.
- Children will deepen their knowledge of fractions, decimals and percentages including conversion, equivalencies and finding amounts using reasoning skills
- Children will also be introduced to algebraic formulas and expressions



 Children will be exploring Blogging. They will look at what a blog is, how they are used, and how they are created.

Music

 Children will be looking at A New Year Carol from Benjamin Britten's Friday Afternoons.
They will be working towards singing the original song and an Urban Gospel version of the song.

Religion

 The children will continue with their learning of Christianity through the life and teaching of Jesus.



English

- Children will be focusing on the text Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone by J.K. Rowling
- They will be writing a newspaper report focussing on Harry Potter's first ever Quidditch match.
- Children will be learning to build stamina within their writing as well as making their writing cohesive and structured by using their publishing and editing skills



Physical Development

 This term children will be practicing gymnastics including forward rolls, cartwheels, balancing and focusing on agility.

<u>Topic</u>

- In Geography children will be developing their understanding of coastal processes and landforms
 - In History, the children will develop their understanding of the Roman Empire and how the Empire impacted Britain.



Science

- This term children will be investigating electrical circuits, building on their learning in previous years.
- They will conduct experiments to find out what happens when multiple units are added to a single battery and how that impacts their performance.



PSHE

- Children will be looking at gender differences as well as exploring ways to change negative gender differences we encounter
