#### MATHEMATICS

- Children will learn about how to count in tenths as decimals, converting fractions into decimals, comparing and ordering fractions and add/subtract fraction
- They will learn about Money. They will add and subtract money. They will also learn to find change.
- · Children will learn about Time, Roman numerals, reading an analogue clock to the nearest 5 and 1 minute.

### TOPIC
