MATHEMATICS

- Children will learn about Money. They will add and subtract money. They will also learn to find change.
- Children will learn about statistics; they will interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables



COMPUTING

Graphing and Branching Databases

- · Children will learn to sort objects using just YES/NO questions using a branching database. They will collect data and create a branching database of the children's choices in their class

MUSIC
