How Parents Can Help

Selected children will go swimming on a Thursday each term.

MATHEMATICS

- This term, children will be looking at negative numbers. They will also begin consolidating the 4 calculations.
- Children will work on converting units.
- Children will continue to learn position and direction.



COMPUTING

Word Processing

- Children will learn how to touch type and familiarise themselves with software.



RE

- Children will learn about Islam and study important stories that form the foundation of the religion



ENGLISH

- This term the children will be studying 'The Goldfish Boy'. Children will write an essay about the importance of not judging others.
- They will also create a character description using a range of sentence types.



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- This term, children will be preparing for Sports day by focussing on athletic events during their sessions.
